To be eligible to participate in Special Olympics, an athlete must be at least eight years old and have been identified by an agency or medical/educational professional as having an intellectual disability; a cognitive delay or have significant learning or vocational problems. Significant learning or vocational problems refer to those learning problems resulting from cognitive delays (intellectual impairment). These do not include physical disability, emotional or behavioral difficulties (ADD or ADHD) or specific disabilities such as dyslexia, or speech or language impairment.
