3. Supper will be provided for the bus on Saturday.
4. If you want, bring snacks/treats. We always have some snacks/water on the bus. NO glass bottles on the bus.
5. **Bring sunscreen.**
6. Pillows and Pillow cases will be provided. You will be responsible for bringing bedding extra-long twin sheets), blankets, towels, washcloths, and all personal care items
7. Pack only 1 bag. Do not bring any valuables. Remember, we are staying on campus and will be walking to everything, so wear comfortable shoes.
8. Don't forget your uniform! The Fireworks uniform is required to participate for all events except swimming. Bring tennis shoes, no street shoes when competing
9. Pack a change of clothes for Saturday. ALL athletes will be required to shower and change their clothes before leaving for home.
10. Be sure watch the weather forecast and pack appropriate clothing.
11. **Again - Bring sunscreen.**
12. Please remember our coaches and people working the events at the tournament are all volunteers! Please be patient with us.
