Schedule & Courts: Arrive 30 mins early. 1st Session: 9:00 AM–12:00 PM | 2nd Session: 1:00 PM–4:00 PM. Traditional & some Unified play AM; Unified plays PM. Games will start early if the previous game is finished. Please be on time. Some divisions may play on more than one court due to large numbers and time slots available. Please look this over carefully.

Site Info Food trucks on site Friday. Team camps allowed outside flagged areas (no shade). Bring your own lawn chairs & water bottles (water jugs will be placed throughout the courts). Fans/families/delegations should bring their own chairs to watch bocce. There will be no bleachers available.

Parking & Shuttle: Bocce lot is restricted to ADA parking & Drop-off/Pick-up ONLY. NO parking at RCCHS (school in session). ALL spectator, volunteer & bus parking is at Civic Center/Monument lot (follow SOSD signs). Free shuttle available from Civic Center Parking lot. People can utilize bike trail that connects the designated parking lots to the Bocce courts.

No opening ceremonies. Please head to the field you play on, and we will do the athlete oath, sportsmanship statement.
